She also now edits the monthly CA Newsletter and the Yearbook, and is a member of the CA's Council. Camilla started dinghy sailing with her late husband Sam in 1986, eventually buying a Westery Storm 33, Kalessin of Orwell, which they sailed from Suffolk to the Netherlands, France, Spain, Portugal and the Baltic with their sons. After Sam died in 2024 Camilla sailed around most of Britain. Kalessin is now up for sale and, like you, Camilla is looking for cheaper ways to go boating.
