DETAILS OF OUR RALLY

Our September Rally will be at Bucklers Hard Yacht Harbour with a drinks reception, DIY BBQ (BBQs and charcoal provided) and the chance to chat over our summer cruising prior to sharing our photos in November. If you don't fancy barbecuing the Chilli Chain should be on hand to serve freshly made chilli and nachos.

There is a £10 rally entry fee to cover the cost of marquee and BBQ hire.

Mooring will be on the walk-ashore visitor pontoons adjacent to the fuel pumps with the likelihood of some rafting. Marina staff should be on hand to direct mooring. Please call 'Beaulieu River Radio' on VHF Channel 68 prior to arrival saying you are part of the Cruising Association Rally.

Our mobiles are 07889049801/07920519610 should you need them. Please come and say hello on arrival.

At 1800 members and their guests are invited to a drinks reception by the marquee on the hard standing opposite the Harbour Office/Chandlery. Please bring your own glasses. For later the Solent Cellar will be running a bar nearby – payment by credit card only – or BYO.

Please apply promptly as we have to provide Bucklers Hard with confirmation and all boat details two weeks prior. You will then be required to pay your mooring fees not less than 7 days in advance of your arrival to secure your berth– see below.

- **All bookings are provisional until confirmed by Bucklers Hard after payment of mooring fees.**
- **Discounted rally berthing rates at £4.05 per meter per night include electricity and water. Upon arrival you must confirm your arrival to the Harbour Office/staff.**

Berthing charges

Each boat is responsible for payment of their own berthing charges at least 7 days prior to arrival - see separate instructions.

NOTES ON THE GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO THE RUNNING OF A MEET, RALLY OR CRUISE-IN-COMPANY

1. Vessels attending the events are to be covered by adequate third party and public liability insurance. Minimum £2,000,000 for any one accident.
2. The Event Organisers and Organising Body shall not be in any way liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner, skipper, his/her crew or other persons on a boat, as a result of their taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company. Moreover, every skipper/owner warrants the suitability of his/her yacht/boat for the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company and that his/her boat is insured for taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company;
3. When on a Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company with the CA the safety of any yacht/boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/skipper who must ensure that the yacht/boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a crew of sufficient number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/skipper must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all other gear. He/she must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in-date and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is to be used.

PLEASE CONFIRM:

The vessel is insured with:(name of company) and I have Third Party and Public Liability insurance cover of at least £2,000,000 for any one accident. My insured cruising range covers the area relevant to this event. I am aware that the Cruising Association and the Rally organisers accept no responsibility for the safety of my vessel, or its crew. The decision to sail and all handling of the vessel and its tender are the responsibility of the skipper who should take his decisions knowing the abilities of his vessel and of his crew.
