Our Fitting Out Rally will be at Shepards Wharf Marina. It will, as always, be very informal and a chance to meet up with old friends and welcome new.

Shepards Wharf Marina is on the west side of the River Medina opposite the Red Funnel ferry terminal. Before entering the marina call "Shepards Wharf" on Channel 80 for instructions and say you are part of the Cruising Association Rally. (If no reply please call on Channel 69.)

On Saturday - At *1800 prompt*, members and their guests are invited to a pontoon reception alongside *High Barbaree*, when you can meet other members and join in the fun of this occasion. Please bring your own glasses.

Dinner on Saturday will be at 1900 at the nearby Tonino's Italian Restaurant. You will be able to make your selection from their full menu which will be circulated in advance for you to make your choices and save time at the restaurant.

Please apply promptly as we have to provide the Marina with confirmation and all boat details one week prior. You will then be required to pay your mooring fees in advance of your arrival to secure your berth– see below.

- All bookings are provisional until confirmed by Shepards Marina office.
- Discounted rally berthing rates for 2022: £2.88 per metre per night.
- Electricity (if required) set rate of £3.80 per boat per night.
- Shepards is a rafting Marina and you will be rafted alongside a pontoon berth.
- Berths will be allocated either in the visitor basins or on the outside pontoons. Vessels must not arrive in the Marina prior to 1200 hours.
- Upon arrival you must confirm your arrival to the Marina office.

NOTES ON THE GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO THE RUNNING OF A MEET, RALLY OR CRUISE-IN-COMPANY

- 1. Vessels attending the events are to be covered by adequate third party and public liability insurance. Minimum £2,000,000 for any one accident;
- 2. The Event Organisers and Organising Body shall not be in any way liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner, skipper, his/her crew or other persons on a boat, as a result of their taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company. Moreover, every skipper/owner warrants the suitability of his/her yacht/boat for the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company and that his/her boat is insured for taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company and that his/her boat is insured for taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company.
- 3. When on a Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company with the CA the safety of any yacht/boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/skipper who must ensure that the yacht/boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a crew of sufficient number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/skipper must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all other gear. He/she must ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in-date and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is to be used.
