Meet Details

Chichester Harbour's attraction is that it is a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Berthing. Space for 6 boats has been reserved on the Visitors' Pontoon which is moored in the Itchenor Reach above the HM Pontoon. Mooring can be alongside and by rafting-up in pairs outside a member (Look for the CA Rally Flag, Burgee or Ensign). We will try to get all the boats grouped together at one end and there are 2 sides to the pontoon.

There will be a Chichester Harbour HM visitor's overnight fee of £8.20/->9m boat, £10.30/->14m boat which the HM Patrol will collect.

Meet Features. The nearby village of Itchenor is attractive and has a splendid pub, The Ship Inn. There is a pleasant circular walk from the HM jetty, or take the ferry to the north side and walk to Bosham (45min+). We can get to Itchenor Hard by own dinghy or by the Itchenor Ferry; call 'Ferry' on Ch 8 or mobile: 07970 378 350.

Evening Meal. Dinner has been arranged at the nearby Itchenor Sailing Club and the Alethea has a dory which can ferry to and from the club

The meal is self service at **£15.00** per person. Two of the 'Ballina Whalers' <http://www.theballinawhalers.com/> will entertain the party with Shanties.

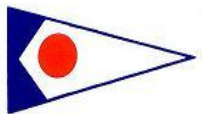

Notes on the General Conditions applicable to the running of a Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company

1. The vessel is insured and I have Third Party and Public Liability insurance cover for the amount specified below. (The level of cover to be not less than the minimum normally provided by the vessels' insurer).
2. The Event Organisers and Organising Body shall not be in any way liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner, skipper, his/her crew or other persons on a boat, as a result of their taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company. Moreover, every skipper/owner warrants the suitability of his/her yacht/boat for the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company and that his/her boat is insured for taking part in the Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company;
3. When on a Meet, Rally or Cruise-in-Company with the CA the safety of any yacht/boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/skipper who must ensure that the yacht/boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a crew of sufficient number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather. The owner/skipper must be satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails and all other gear.
