'The Frozen North: Orkneys, Iceland, nearly to Greenland (until stopped by ice), Faroes'

Alan started sailing aged 10 and since then has sailed around 20,000 miles, mainly single-handed, including round Britain, round Ireland, the Baltic & Norway.

This is the story of his attempt on Greenland via the Orkneys, the Faeroes and Iceland, taking 3 months and 3000 miles.
